Austyn de Lugo (he/him/él) is an artist working in collage, textiles, and painting. His work is influenced by political portraiture, family photos, floral photos, and decorative arts. His current body of work draws from his family’s history in Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands, as well as revolutionary movements in the Caribbean. He considers the United States’ relationship with its colonies in the Caribbean, and imagines how tropicity can be used as a site of political resistance. Austyn has exhibited in the US and abroad. In 2017, he was the Artist-in-Residence at the Fundación Sebastian in Mexico City.
